have begun logging hours 5/1/12 to be reported at month's end for a goal of 30 hours a month.

Volunteers for COPS and members of MPNA should stress to the community they are separate entities.

Recent modifications since the last COPS training are:

• All patrolling must be done in a vehicle and not on foot.

• You must go in person to the police state to submit out of town forms requesting additional

police security.

• Houston Endowment grant awarded \$300 for "Poop bags" in all four corners of the schools. It is

against the law to not pick up after your animals.

funds remaining from MPNA if disbanded will be given to nonprofit orgs, etc.). Kathleen makes a motion to
