The Museum Park Neighborhood Association endorses the comments submitted by Museum Park Super Neighborhood regarding the Community Parking Program Ordinance, the Parking Benefit District Ordinance, and the Time Limit Implementation Policy currently being developed by City of Houston, Parking Management. The inclusion of suggested changes into these ordinances is critical to parking ordinances that function well for residents, businesses, institutions, and the millions of visitors to Museum Park each year.

MPNA is submitting a few additional requests expressed by members.

Museum Park Neighborhood Association additional comments:

Sec. 26-753. Please include language that assures advisory committee will include resident representation.

Sec. 26-761 Definitions - 2 Adding to MPSN request for meter installation in current bus zones during business hours, MPNA respectfully requests that these spaces be more flexible. Using the model for managed special events downtown, 'red covers' can be used to reserve bus parking when placed over the meters only on the days needed for buses. The bus zone parking spaces are empty on many days during the week and most weekends, especially during summer months. Such a policy will maximize use of the public right of way and should reduce the impact of future demand for parking on residential streets in the neighborhood

Sec. 781. Please include clarification of parking permit eligibility for condos/apartments with more than 60 units.

In Time Limit Policy, please emphasize, "All streets near newly installed meters will be deemed eligible for time limited parking."
